Do each step in this manual multiple times until the children are completely comfortable with the concepts. What takes 3-year-olds weeks of repetition may take 5-year-olds only one or two times to comprehend....but just think where those 3-year-olds are going to be by the time they are 5!!!

STEP TWO

SING along & Move every day!

COLOR CODING



My Right Hand and Left Hand Pointers










Circle Groups of 2 Black Keys A free FunSheet from Busy Buzzy Bumblebee.
