

SPOT for DOTS

The Anybody Can Play website has many fun activities/worksheets on the Resource Page.

Markers and crayons work well for “one time” activities, but for activities done multiple times on laminated displays, it works well to use removable, reusable colored dots of some kind.

There is an added advantage too.....
By letting each child have a laminated “SPOT for DOTS” you not only teach the child the activity at hand, but give each child his/her own set of colors to use - and later properly put away.

The children really seem to appreciate a designated set of their own personal colored dots. Many even put their dots away in a pretty little pattern.

The easiest way to “make” removable, reusable dots is to use white rectangular 1/2 in wide removable stickers, bend down one end slightly so it is easy to remove. Color code the white sticker with colored stickers, markers....whatever.

Cut apart the SPOT for DOTS sheets and laminate for repeated use.

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
