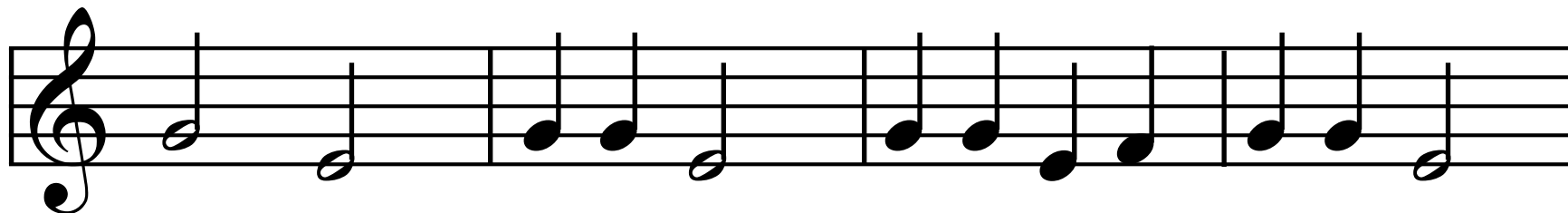

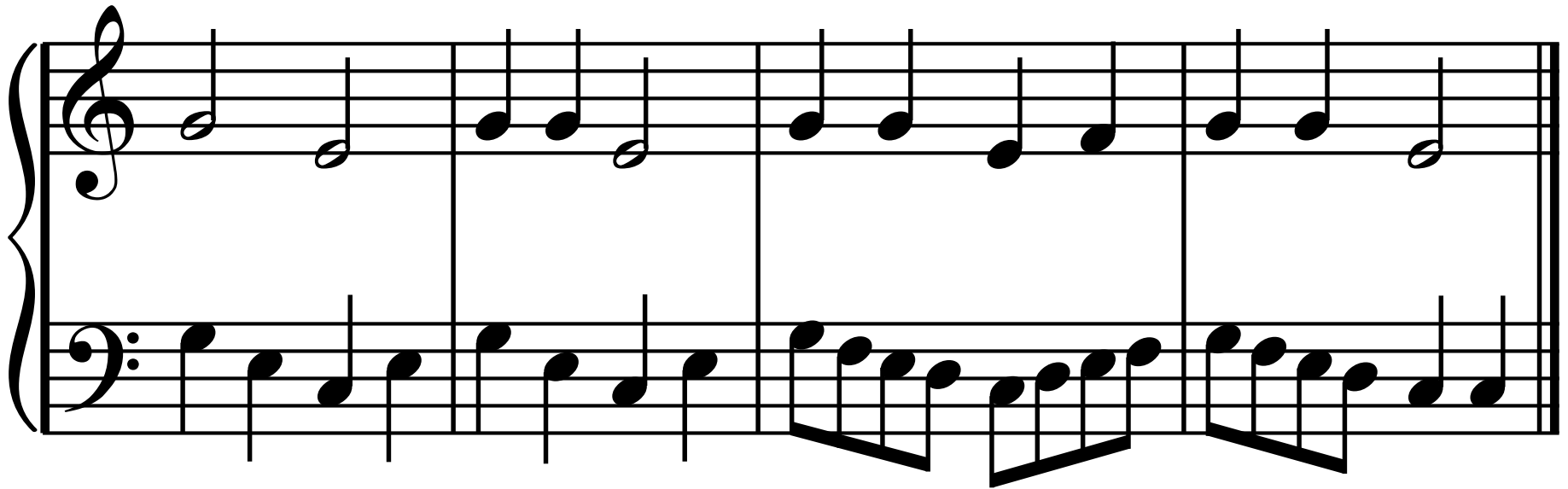

GENERAL INFORMATION

Rain Rain Go Away uses the three middle fingers of the hand. Using the ring finger is sometimes quite difficult for a young beginner, so in that case just skip this song for the time being.

The levels are listed by difficulty - easy to harder. You will notice that in Level 3 this is not the second song! When learning the songs with the app the Levels 1 and 2 are generally learned quite well before going on to Level 3. So the order change in Level 3 is not an issue.

Again, use Keystrips if necessary for controllers or piano keyboards.

Some children may be learning to note read from the beginning while others are too young. However, very young children like to be able to recognize and name objects even before they know how to use them. Two year olds even like to tell you that the shape you see is called a quarter note, then point to the stem and note head as they tell you the names, then add that quarter notes just walk walk walk!
