

All My Fingers!

This step adds the final 3 colors for coding the right hand. Do place the color coded hands in places where the children see them.

When playing the Finger Dot Game, hold up the color coded hand sheet until the children have internalized the color codes for the fingers.

The Dot Game internalizes seeing the color and automatically touching the proper finger - memory reflex.

As always, stay on this step until the children are comfortable and fully understand the concept and function effortlessly.

And, review activities of previous steps if you feel the children need it. Repeating what is learned improves the skill and gives the children confidence.

Daily Activities for Step 3

1. Give each child a minimum of 5 minutes on the app. Mark practice chart for each.

Sing and Move.....

Keep singing Tick Tock with words and colors.

2. Add the "Rain Rain Go Away" song if you haven't already done so - again with words and colors. Add motions!

3. Introduce, then review worksheet for all 5 right hand finger colors.

4. Play the Finger Dot Game with the Dot Sheet.
