

Level 3 begins using terminology that students will use in other musical activities, such as the names of the piano keys.

Again, just make sure everyone has the materials they need and are, indeed, working on them.

Under Step By Step there is the term "Extras..." In an After School program there may be students who have already taken piano lessons. When I find something of interest there that can enhance any piano lesson, I will post it on that page, so check once in awhile (and remember to always "Refresh" the page).

Again, look at some of the activity sheets and if you have the chance, ask the students to explain what they have learned.

And remind the teachers - AND the students - that the Anybody Can Play PIANO app is what actually teaches them to play songs. It is very important that they are able to play these songs by memory and on any piano or keyboard that is not connected to the app.

Also impress on teachers and students that it is important that they are able to sing the songs on the app. And, when they are able to play the songs to also be able to sing along as they play! This is something many pianists are unable to do! It is a skill that has to be learned and is easy to do if done from the beginning:)
