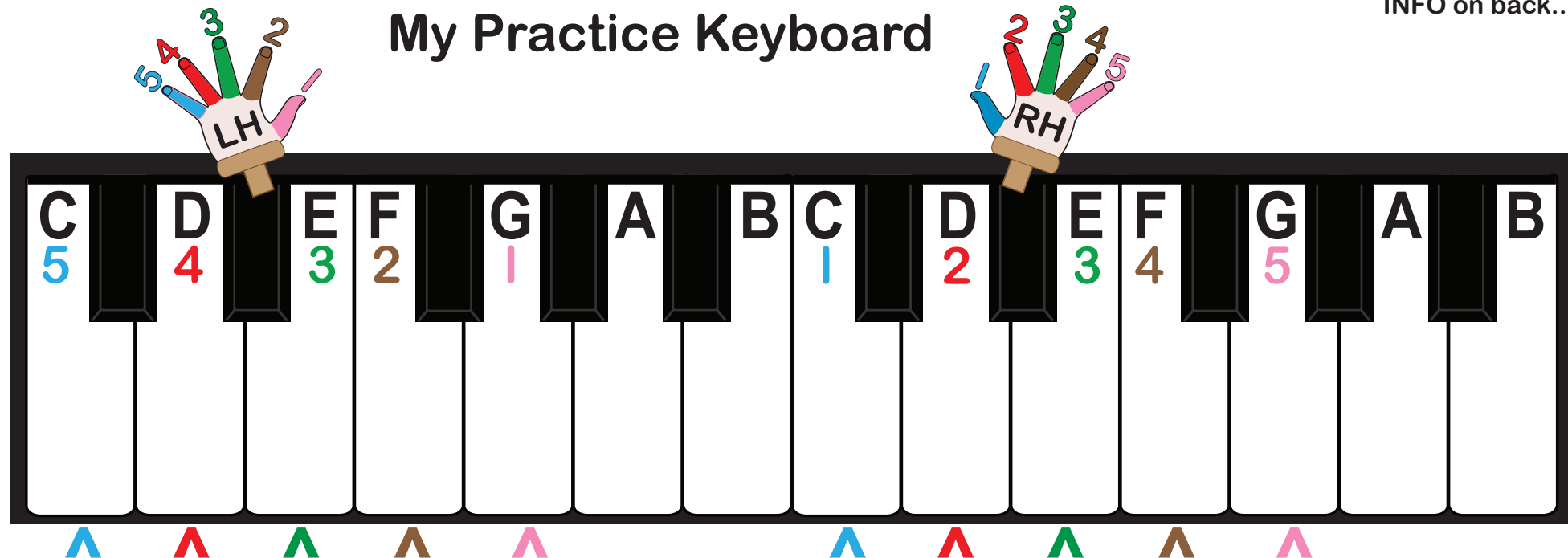

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My Practice Keyboard



The children have been learning to do many different things on the piano keyboard.

If you are so moved, ask your child to show you how to do the following activities on this practice keyboard which has keys sized similarly to mini keyboards. (Different brands are all slightly different sizes!)

Playing the same tune with both hands at the same time is not that easy because our hands are mirror imaged so different fingers have to be used on keys that look the same!

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PRACTICE ACTIVITIES:

Tap one “color” at a time through songs already learned saying colors, or numbers, or singing the words.

Make up Silly Songs on the keyboard playing fingers one at a time matching finger colors to those colored keys on the keyboard drawing and also hands together on keys that have the same name or color using the correctly colored fingers.

As the children progress, keep asking your child to show you the new things that are being learned.
