# Dots on Keys GAME

These games are for solidifying the finger colors.

The sheet with GAME 2 and GAME 3 are more simple than the GAME 1 sheet.

## PREPARATION

GAME 2 & 3 Sheet:

Cut out the sheet with GAME 2 and 3 using the dotted lines as guides.

Laminate both dotted keyboards in an 8 1/2 by 11 inch pouch, spacing them so there is laminate around each "game".

Cut, curve corners.

GAME 1 Sheet:

Simply laminate the entire sheet of GAME 1.

## INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE:

Give each child an identical game sheet.

At the beginning, just do one hand at a time. When the children are able to do each hand alone, do hands together.

## RIGHT HAND ALONE:

Say a color.

Have children touch the key with a round dot in that color with their right hand finger that is the "same color".

## LEFT HAND ALONE:

Same as right hand, only use rounded square dots with the left hand colors.

## BOTH HANDS TOGETHER:

Have children touch a certain color with both right and left hands - being careful that the right hand finger touches the round dot color and the left hand finger touches the rounded square dot color.
