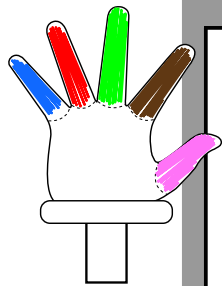
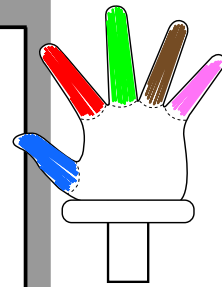
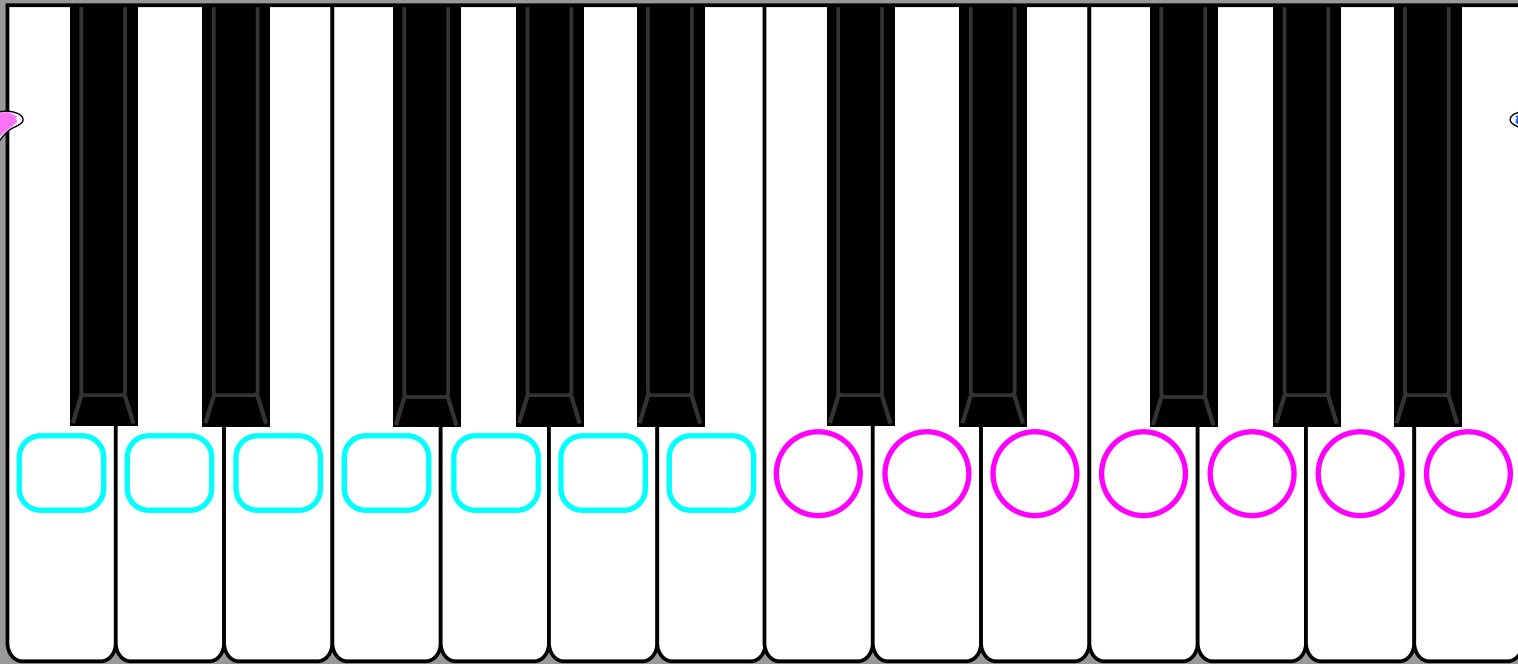
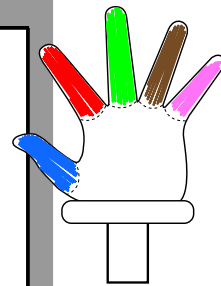
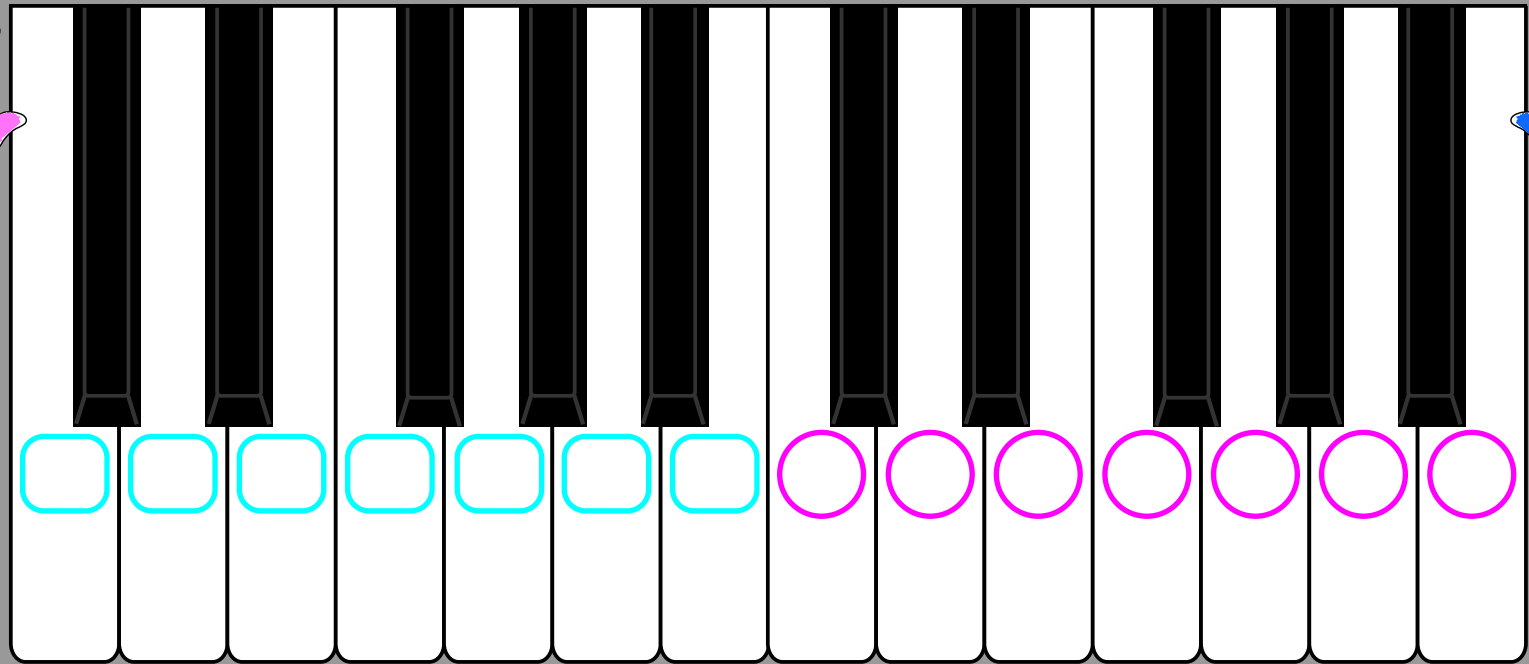


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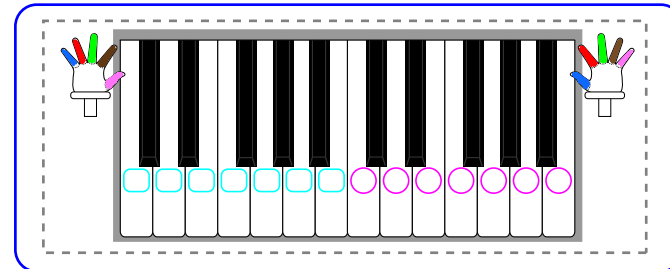


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Level 2

This is an activity sheet that should be laminated.
Cut apart along dotted lines.
Laminate so there is clear laminate around the keyboard
since wet cloths will be used on it to wipe off markings
so it needs to be waterproof.

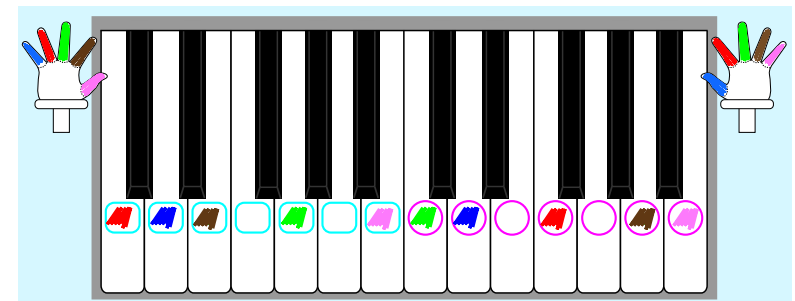


Using washable marker, mark your teacher's copy with each of the 5 finger colors in any order in the rectangular boxes. Do the same in the circles. Have the students mark their keyboards with colors in the same order as your keyboard.

Name a color. When you name a color students touch the key with that color marked on it with both their left and right hands.

Name another color...touch those keys.....name another color.....

Let students also take turns "being the teacher", marking their keyboard and having the other students copy the markings onto their keyboards, then naming color after color as students touch the proper keys with their proper fingers.



Example of color marked keys:
Fingers of the left hand touch keys with the boxes and fingers of the right hand touch keys with the circles.
