





Many young children have not had a lot of experience with letters - less drawing them. This is an exercise to solidify recognition of the letter B - and actually give them some experience tracing around the B in order to learn how to write the letter themselves.

Use the plain B or the one with the arrows.

Cut off along top line.

Laminate.

Cut around each car and laminate within a credit card pouch.

Start driving from the top red star.

Drive down along the left side to the bottom.

Stop at stop sign.

Go back to the red star.

Drive to the right, following the green dotted lines.

At the end of the green dotted lines, make a U turn and follow the pink dotted lines.

Go all the way to the end and stop.

It is a good idea to go through the instructions while having them watch you doing the driving, then go through the instructions again with the kids.
