







DRIVE AROUND THAT D

Many young children have not had a lot of experience with letters - less drawing them. This is an exercise to solidify recognition of the letter D - and actually give them some experience tracing around the D in order to learn how to write the letter themselves.

Use the plain D or the one with the arrows.

Cut off along top line.

Laminate.

Cut around each car and laminate within a credit card pouch.

Start at the red star.

Drive straight down along the dotted green lines.

Stop at the Stop Sign.

Now go back to the red star, turn right and drive along the green dotted lines around to the Stop Sign.

It is a good idea to go through the instructions while having them watch you doing the driving, then go through the instructions again with the kids.
