







DRIVE AROUND THAT F

Many young children have not had a lot of experience with letters - even less drawing them. This is an exercise to solidify recognition of the letter F - and actually give them some experience tracing around the F in order to learn how to write the letter themselves.

Use the plain F or the one with the arrows.

Cut off along top line.

Laminate.

Cut around each car and laminate within a credit card pouch.

This is easy when you already know how to drive around E!

Start at the green star.

Drive straight down along the dotted green lines.

Stop at the Stop Sign.

Go to red star. Drive along dotted red line. Stop.

Go to blue star. Drive along dotted blue line. Stop.

It is a good idea to go through the instructions while having them watch you doing the driving, then go through the instructions again with the kids doing the "driving".
